The El Dorado Chamber of Commerce’s 29th Annual Fantastic Fourth Celebration will be held on the Fourth of July, which is on a Saturday this year.

The day will kick off with the all new “Liberty Run, Ride for the Stars and Stripes.” The Liberty Run will begin and end in the Barton Library parking lot. A cash prize will also be given to the winner of the People’s Choice Award. The event is free to the public. There is a \$15 entry fee for the judged category and an \$8 entry fee to display only. On site registration will begin at 9 a.m. Participants will be eligible for a drawing for prizes provided by Hurry Back and Sherwin Williams Automotive.
